



Land Maintenance Workers, Community and Trails

6 months, Short-Term Full-Time Contract

Job Summary

The Heiltsuk Tribal Council Economic Development Department is seeking two motivated individuals to contribute to trail rebuild and community maintenance. This position will require the individuals to assist the trail crew lead in building a sustainable trail throughout the next few months.

Other responsibilities include trail clean up of Martins Lake and some clean up of garbage and debris on land & other general duties in and around our community.

Duties

1. General Trail Maintenance
 - Assist with recreation, and rerouting, of trails systems.
 - i. Shovel dirt/mud, relocate mud.
 - ii. Arrange rocks, various sizes; Layers under the trail and alongside the trail
 - iii. Cover with wood chips.
 - iv. Remove dangerous debris.
 - Working with trail lead on trail design
 - Plan and redesign trails to serve the needs of multiple user groups.
 - Equipment use, maintenance and care.
 - Maintaining trails for multipurpose use
 - Filling in holes in trail surface
 - Removal of unwanted debris and garbage
 - Collaborate with organizations to arrange pick up/drop off of garbage/debris collected.
2. Community Cleanup
 - Tend to the cleanup of the hub of our community.
 - i. Includes picking up litter, and storage of garbage until we can transport it to Solid Waste
 - ii. Arrange pick up/ drop off
3. Other related duties

The duties listed are provided as examples of area of responsibility and are not intended to create limits to responsibility but to help understand the scope of the position.
